We decided not to participate in this year's Victorian Stroll.

The Sheldons' Produce Pickup Project, which provides free fresh produce 4 days/week, has helped two homeless families from St Catherine's.

Greg requested a club donation of \$1000 to pay a local resident to supervise 3-5 kids who would be paid by the Albany's Winter Youth Employment program to perform winter clean-up and maintenance tasks at the blueberry orchard.

Greg's request led to a long discussion in which IPDG Michele stressed the importance of making sure all our legal bases were covered regarding the blueberry orchard. We were remiss in not responding to the Memo of Understanding from Eden's Rose Foundation two years ago, and we should get that clarified asap. We should also have all board members sign the various policies that we should be complying with as a 501(c)(3): Conflict of Interest, Equality, etc. And we must ensure that all our financial records are in proper order to satisfy our various grantors.

In email votes after the meeting, we passed a motion to donate \$250 to Vanderheyden, and we passed a motion to buy 5 \$20 tickets for the Lions Eye Bank raffle.
