Report of the general meeting held on Wednesday, April 6, at the Red Front

We had a last-minute cancellation of our scheduled speaker, but program chair Kathy Dorn was able to bring in two young ladies from Hope Club, the Latham-based community support



facility of the American Cancer Society. Liz Hunter and Chris Ravel explained Hope Club's many activities and programs that they offer for those touched by cancer and their families. The Club has support groups and activities for all ages. They also talked about ACS's three big fundraisers: Gala of Hope (April 30), Red, White and Blue Party (June 21) and Coaches vs Cancer Basket "Ball" (in September). Relay for Life is a 24-hour event that takes place in about 30 different locations around the capital region. Funds raised are used for research, education, prevention and support.

The proposed slate of 2016-17 officers and board of directors was unanimously approved (see page 2).

On Wednesday, April 27, Lion Jerry attended a meeting with PDG Ed Stano, 20Y2's Global Membership Chair; PDG Joe Jarvis, Global Leadership Chair; Lion Fred Koch, Leo Chair; Lion Sue Jenner, member of NY Cosmopolitan LC and founder of NY Tribeca Campus LC; Dr Diane Dewar, professor at UAlbany School of Public Health; Sylvia Byun, Lauren Fitzgerald and Devin Smith, grad students at SPH. We met on the SPH campus in Rensselaer.

Lauren will be president next year of the Grad Student Organization, which already performs a variety of service projects related to public health. We (the Lions) told them what Lionism is all about, and how it would benefit them to operate as a Lions Club. 
