

Report of the board meetings held via teleconference on Wednesday, May 6:

Lion Tom shipped another 5500 glasses to the NJ recycling center.

Lion Eva's committee is developing a food-delivery program.

Lion Preem is still cataloging her pin collection and plans to attend to 2021 Intl convention in Montreal.

Lions John & Tom have no fund-raising report.

We voted to again participate in Boscov's Friends Helping Friends program.

Lion Mike O'Brien reported that Lion Mike Farrell had fallen in Feb and was now in a rehab facility in Catskill.

Our installation dinner would normally be held on June 3, but it doesn't seem likely considering the ongoing coronavirus conditions. We decided to just keep an eye on the evolving situation.

Lion Ruth has had no new eyeglass requests.

Lion Jerry received one hearing-aid application from a 90-yr-old Troy resident. She meets our financial guidelines and the board approved her, assuming the HCS will share the \$750 cost with us, as they have so generously in the past. [The HCS subsequently approved the share and her hearing aids are now on order.]

As mentioned in the last Rare Meat, Lions Irv and Eva distributed several cases of chocolate bunnies in the Arbor Hill and South End neighborhoods, as well as some in Watervliet.

District 20W received a \$10,500 grant from LCIF to provide meals to the front-line personnel at five area hospitals (Albany Med, St Peter's, Albany Memorial, Samaritan, and Ellis). Lion Jerry has arranged to get 2100 meals from the three local Popeye's franchises and has put together a schedule for a daily delivery to each hospital at either 11:30 AM or 4:30 PM. He'll be looking for drivers to bring the meals from Popeye's to the hospitals.

Lion Greg has arranged for the purchase of hand sanitizer from Grateful Villages @\$2.80/2-oz bottle with our name on the label. We approved an expenditure up to \$1000 to donate these to our local police departments. The first 100 went to Albany PD and 133 will go to the Troy PD. Lion Carol is looking into other PDs in our bailiwick (Colonie, Rensselaer, Watervliet, Menands, Green Island, etc).

Our blueberry orchard needs hoses for irrigation, fencing, and signage. Lions Greg and Jerry will look into getting 600' of hose donated by Home Depot, Lowe's, or equivalent. Lions Eva and Carol will come up with a sign design. Lions Greg and Jordan will look into sources for fencing.



Lions & COVID-19: Helping the police

We have given 100 bottles of hand sanitizer to the Albany Police Department, who were very appreciative. We have polled other PDs within our service area (Colonie, Troy, Rensselaer, N Greenbush, E Greenbush, Watervliet, Green Island) and serving all of them would require another 500 bottles. For a total cost of \$1680. The board already approved \$1000 towards this project but now have to consider this higher amount. One possibility is to apply for a NYS&BLF matching grant. This would cut our total cost to \$840, but we couldn't get that approved before October.
