Report of the Zoom meetings held on Sept 1

General meeting:

Lion Greg brought us up to speed on the blueberry orchard: On Aug 18, about a dozen employees of Maximus helped us plant another 144 blueberry bushes in the vacant half of our orchard. These bushes were somewhat more mature than the ones we got for our first planting two years ago, so they should be more productive. In addition to Maximus, we partnered with Siena College, who provided summer interns that we needed for manual labor. This wouldn't have been possible without the generous grant from United Way of the Greater Capital Region and a smaller grant from Pioneer Bank. With the sign that went up back in July, the whole orchard is much more impressive-looking now, but the work is still on-going.

Club & Charitable Fund board meetings:

KL Eva plans to meet with all VPs and committee chairs to talk about recruiting volunteers.

Lion Preem says that everyone has to be vaccinated to work with the kids at NABA, so the Leos met at the Albany Boys & Girls Club in August. They had a speaker from the Albany Police Dept, and they are planning a social event.

We voted to participate in NABA's Low-Vision Tech Fair, as we have in the past. It's on Oct 20 from 9 AM-noon at the Albany Jewish Community Center.

Boscov's "Friends Helping Friends" discount cards have been mailed to all members to be sold for \$5 each, all of which we keep. *[See page 2]*

We agreed to apply for another ACDA grant for \$15k to supply hand sanitizer to school children.

Lion Jerry has one hearing-aid request and one eye-surgery request.

We've got 1000 tickets to sell. They're available now, so let's go! Tell Lion Jerry how many you want to start with.


