Minutes of the meetings held on Sept 7 at the Red Front

To start the general meeting, DG Ricky Laurin spoke about the importance of setting club goals, but not being overly ambitious – per-

haps 3 or 4 goals per year. We should be working in the local community with schools, churches and other orgs. He made many references to Stephen Covey's 7 Habits of Highly Effective People, a book DG has clearly taken to heart and benefitted from. It includes such pearls as "Begin with the end in mind" and "Seek first to understand, then to be understood."

He also spoke about a plastic recycling program that the district will be involved with – stay tuned for more info.




