Report of the meetings held Nov 6 at The Eleven

The meeting was called to order about 6:00 PM by Pres Jodi.

The minutes of the last meeting and the treasurer's report, which had been distributed previously, were accepted as submitted.

DH Holly presented Larry with a chevron for 45 years of service, and inducted new members Nikki Milton, Mike Suske and Chloe Tarlen.

She then covered a number of topics:


